A \$15,000 benefit payable if your death occurs as a direct result of a covered accidental bodily injury sustained while insured, provided death occurs within 365 days of the accident.

If a covered accident results in your death, your beneficiary will receive 100% of your AD&D coverage amount.

Receive up to a maximum of 100% of your AD&D coverage amount for losses resulting from one accident.

If you disappear as a result of an accidental wrecking, sinking, etc. in which you were a passenger and your body is not found in 365 days, you will be presumed dead due to an accidental bodily injury.

How it Works

If you are an active, dues-paying PEF member you are automatically covered for \$15,000 of AD&D insurance at no cost to you. You or your beneficiary(ies) will receive a payment if you suffer a covered accidental injury or an accidental death.

Beneficiary Designation Form

Designate Your Beneficiaries

Designate the person(s) or entity that will receive the money from your policy's accidental death benefit when you pass away. Your beneficiary can be: family, siblings, close friends, neighbors, even institutions, or charities. Review your designations annually because your beneficiaries on your insurance trump your will and trust plan. You can change them any time.
